Description	<p>One week of Ophthalmology and one week of Dermatology (students must do both weeks). Specialty topics in the AM, general topics in the PM.</p> <p>Each week will contain 20 hours of specialty-specific content and 20 hours per week of content designed for students across all specialties participating in the elective. The Ophthalmology and Dermatology curriculum will explore equitable healthcare within that specialty through patient interviews, case presentations, lecture series, health humanities exercises, and team discussion, allowing students to refine their skills while networking with residents and faculty. A health systems science-based curriculum across specialties will cover topics such as health disparities, global health, Baltimore's patient population and professional development.</p>
