

San Diego Tourist Attractions by Hilton Bayfront Concierge

Old Town Trolley Tours: Narrated 2-hour trolley tour of San Diego. Tours are hop-on-hop-off and run a 32-mile loop stopping at popular locations throughout San Diego. Tour pick up is right outside the hotel on Harbor Drive under the pedestrian bridge. First pick up here is at 9.10am and comes by every 20 minutes. Discount tickets at Concierge.

Harbor Tours: Flagship has a variety of one-to-two hour narrated tours as well as brunch and dinner cruises, all aboard large and well-equipped vessels. Discounted boarding passes available at Concierge desk. 1.5 mile from hotel

Balboa Park: Balboa Park is just minutes from downtown and is the largest urban park in the US. It is home to 17 major museums, several performing arts venues, and beautiful gardens. 2 miles from hotel and free parking

USS Midway: Navy aircraft carrier in her class. Self-guided 1-hour audio tour, narrated by Sailors, takes approximately 2 hours. Open from 10am to 5 pm daily. Discount tickets at Concierge.

San Diego Zoo: The World Famous Zoo is home to thousands of species including endangered Giant Pandas, Elephants, and Rhinos. Brand new Children's area called Wildlife Explorers Basecamp. Free parking. Discount tickets at Concierge.

Gaslamp Quarter: Sitting in the heart of Downtown San Diego, the Gaslamp Quarter boast over 200 restaurants, bars, nightclubs, and lounges. The Gaslamp also has a few boutiques, art galleries and shops.

Seaport Village & The Headquarters: A 14-acre outdoor plaza with 17 eateries, 60 shops and galleries, a beautiful 19th Century carousel and a bayside boardwalk. 1 mile from hotel.

San Diego Maritime Museum: The museum has one of the world's finest collections of historic ships, including the world's oldest active ship Star of India. Their collection of ships and exhibits are available for daily public tours. 2 miles from hotel. Discount tickets at Concierge.

Old Town State Historic Park: The birthplace of California where the first Europeans settled. The finest in professional theater, artisans, galleries and shops are all within easy walking distance of each other with free live entertainment, mariachis, ghost tours, the haunted Whaley House and more. Many great Mexican restaurants and 6 miles from hotel

Little Italy: Trendy and fun area of downtown where India Street is the heart of the neighborhood. Numerous outdoor cafes, Food Hall, hip restaurants, wine bars and specialty shops. 2 miles from hotel.

Sea World: A marine animal theme park that features shows rides, exhibits, and animal interaction. View the penguin and shark encounter aquariums. Discount tickets at Concierge.

Coronado Island: Home to the Historic and iconic Hotel Del Coronado, it is an island of small-town quaintness amid San Diego. Visit the galleries, cafes, boutiques and open beaches. Coronado beach was voted 'The no 1 beach in the US' in Forbes Magazine.

The Safari Park: Located in the beautiful San Pascal Valley 30 miles north of San Diego. It is an extension of the San Diego Zoo where guests can feed and view animals up close. Discount tickets at Concierge.

LEGOLAND / LEGOLAND Waterpark: A Lego themed adventure park. The park offers an assortment of Lego themed attractions, primarily geared to young children and families. The Waterpark is open seasonally, is a splash-filled interactive fun time for the entire family. Discount tickets at Concierge.

Pacific beach/Mission Beach/Mission Bay: Classic Southern California beach with many surfers and a boardwalk filled with people on rollerblades, skateboards and beach cruisers. The two beaches form an unbroken band of sand that stretches for 3 miles. PB especially is overflowing with restaurants, bars and boutiques.

Belmont Park: San Diego's beachfront attraction is sure to please the entire family. Located on the surf and sand at Mission Beach, the park offers free parking. You can enjoy traditional rides like the historical Giant Dipper roller coaster, bumper cars, carousel and The Wave House.

Cabrillo National Monument: At the tip of the Point Loma Peninsula, discover trails, tide pools and an amazing downtown view. Visit the Cabrillo monument; it commemorates the landing of Juan Rodríguez Cabrillo at San Diego Bay on September 28, 1542 as the first European to sail to San Diego. Don't miss the historical Point Loma Lighthouse. This is the southernmost tip of the West coast United States.

La Jolla Cove & La Jolla Shores: La Jolla's spectacular streets are lined with high-end boutiques, antique stores and art galleries. Stroll along winding paths with breathtaking views of sandstone cliffs dropping off into the ocean. Stop by the Children's Pool to check out the seals and sea lions. La Jolla Shores is a sandy beach approximately one mile long where they offer very seven cave kayak tours and snorkel tours. See Concierge for more info.

Torrey Pines State Natural Reserve La Jolla: 2,000 acres of coastal state park featuring incredible ocean views, a world famous golf course and many kinds of wildlife and flora. 8 miles of beautiful hiking trails with a view of La Jolla to the South and Del Mar to the North.
